Re: **Shock Trauma Technician Course**

The Shock Trauma Technician Program provides the technician with specific skills to provide a limited amount of advanced life support (ALS) treatment to patients with traumatic injuries and specific medical conditions. The Shock Trauma Technician is authorized to initiate specific intravenous infusions and administer a limited number of intravenous, subcutaneous and intramuscular medications based upon local medical protocols. Additional skills in airway management and endotracheal medication administration are also included in the program.
