Re: **Mass Casualty Incident Management Module I & II
Incident Command**

The Virginia Mass Casualty Incident Management Module I course will cover what a mass casualty incident is, goals and response actions to a MCI, START triage, accurate casualty count methods, and Virginia triage tags. Module II defines a mass casualty incident, lists the goals of MCI management, relate 5-S to Medical Group operations, identifies the roles in the incident management structure, describes the key roles in the Medical Group, describes basic responsibilities, tools, and tactics for medical group positions, describes the organization of the Medical Group, identifies the focus of Extrication, Triage, Treatment and Transportation Units and how to perform duties in the Medical Group. Incident command training will be taught in addition to the MCIM course.
