Re: **First Responder Course**

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*The First Responder Program is a 40 hour (minimum) course intended to provide a basic understanding of human body systems and lifesaving emergency care procedures. This program is designed to be used by individuals such as fire service, industrial and law enforcement personnel who may be the first person to arrive at the scene of a medical emergency. This course is not primarily intended for individuals whose main duty is the provision of ambulance services. It may however be used as a base level at which individuals are introduced to emergency medical care training.*
