Much of this information was not covered in the Cardiac Technician or Shock Trauma Technician programs. The transition program assumes that the ALS provider has a thorough understanding of the objectives that are primarily taught in the Virginia Cardiac Technician and Shock Trauma Technician Curricula.*
