Vehicle Rescue 2000, Starts Wednesday April 6, 2005 from 18:00 – 22:00 hours and will continue on Thursday April 7, 2005 from 18:00 – 22:00 hours. Practical exercises will be held on Saturday and Sunday April 9th and 10th from 08:00- 18:00 hours. Class will be held at the Waynesboro First Aid Crew. Danny Whitley will be the lead instructor. Students will be expected to bring appropriate PPE consisting of helmet, safety glasses, leather gloves, work shoes, and long sleeves Class will be limited to 15.

EVOC will be held on the weekend of Saturday and Sunday April 9th and 10th at the Waynesboro First Aid Crew. Class will start each day at 0800 hours. Walter Robertson will be the lead instructor.

Farm Machinery Extrication will be held on Friday April 8, 2005 from 1900- 2200 at the Waynesboro First Aid Crew. The class will continue on Saturday and Sunday April 9th and 10th from 0800-1700 hours. Students are expected to bring appropriate PPE consisting of helmets safety glasses, leather gloves and work shoes. Scott Masincup will be the lead instructor.
