

# INTERMEDIATE TO PARAMEDIC BRIDGE PROGRAM

The PVCC/UVA Paramedic Education Program is pleased to announce the offering of an NREMT I/99 to NREMT-P bridge program with a degree track option.

Eligible candidates will:

- be currently certified National Registry Intermediate/99 providers and have a valid HCP CPR card.

- meet all other pre-requisites of the Paramedic Program, including:

  - complete/place out of Math 03 and 09 (Algebra I)

  - complete/place out of Eng 05

    - \*\*Both of these can be accomplished by taking a placement test in the Learning Center at PVCC (and should be completed ASAP)\*\*

  - Chemistry **and** Biology- high school or college passed with a C or better; or completion of NAS II at a Virginia Community College.

    - concurrent** enrollment in Anatomy and Physiology I during fall semester; A&P II during spring semester (unless BIO 141 and 142 have been completed within the last 8 years.)

Class will start August 28, 2007. Students will be expected to spend 6-8 hours/week in the classroom/lab on Tuesdays (4-9pm) and Thursdays (4-8pm), with additional clinical time to be specified/scheduled later.

This will be a rigorous and intense program, only dedicated and committed students should apply; class size will be limited to 12 students. There will be at least two Saturday class sessions in the fall semester. Class will be two semesters, with sessions over winter break and summer session, with goal test date in mid-July 2008.
